## AY2022 Class Implementation Policy at the Graduate School of Economics

In accordance with the “The 2022 University of Tokyo Activity Restrictions Index for Preventing the Spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019” (<https://www.u-tokyo.ac.jp/covid-19/en/policies/index.html#id01>), the policy on the conduct of courses offered in A1A2 terms (AY2022) at the Graduate School of Economics (GSE) is as follows.

<Term A1 and Term A2>

All courses will be conducted face-to-face, but only the first week of classes will be conducted online via Zoom.

- Some classes may be conducted only online.
- The mode of delivery for any course is subject to change due to unavoidable circumstances.
- For the courses not provided at the GSE, please check the information of the Faculties or Graduate schools where the courses are offered since the system may differ from the GSE.

If it is difficult to attend face-to-face classes, students must consult with instructors of the courses at the first class and confirm the way to attend the rest of the classes only in the following cases. Other cases are not acceptable (including the case of being close contact with COVID-19 patients or contracting with COVID-19), so please constantly take care of your health condition.

- Students who have an underlying disease in themselves or a family member living with them and have a strong anxiety about COVID-19 infection.
- International students who have difficulty in coming to Japan due to circumstances beyond their control.

If you have a close contact with COVID-19 patients or contract COVID-19, please check with your instructor as you will have the opportunity to ask questions about the course at the next class or by e-mail.
