

### Class cancellation in case of inclement weather (eg, typhoon)

1. The Faculty/Graduate School of Economics will cancel classes in accordance with the conditions listed below if the Japan Meteorological Agency (Kisho-cho) announces an Emergency Warning (Tokubetsu-keiho) or Storm Warning (Bofu-keiho) in one of Tokyo 23 wards.
  - 1) When announced as of 6 am: 1<sup>st</sup> period cancel
  - 2) When announced as of 8 am: 2<sup>nd</sup> period cancel
  - 3) When announced as of 10 am: 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> periods cancel
  - 4) When announced as of 2 pm: 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> periods cancel
  
2. Additional conditions to follow:
  - 1) When announced at 6 am or later and before 8 am, cancel 1<sup>st</sup> period and follow above 1 for the rest.
  - 2) When announced at 8 am or later and before 10 am, cancel 2<sup>nd</sup> period and follow above 1 for the rest.
  - 3) When announced at 10 am or later and before 2 pm, cancel 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> period and follow above 1 for the rest.
  - 4) When announced at 2 pm or after, cancel 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> period.
  
3. If the mode of transportation one uses experiences significant disruption, or if commuting to school would be dangerous, please do not push oneself to attend. Consider personal safety above all.
